Our Programs

To support Marion Fire District, we provide grants to purchase:

- Fire, rescue, & emergency medical equipment
- Personal protective equipment & gear
- Training
- Meals (when needed during certain long operations)
- Facility upgrades & maintenance

2020 Grants

- \$5,250 for extractor washing machine
(removes carcinogens & blood borne pathogens from firefighter turnouts & EMT uniforms)
- \$3,802 for rope rescue equipment
- \$2,973 down payment on Jaws of Life
- \$1,984 for meals

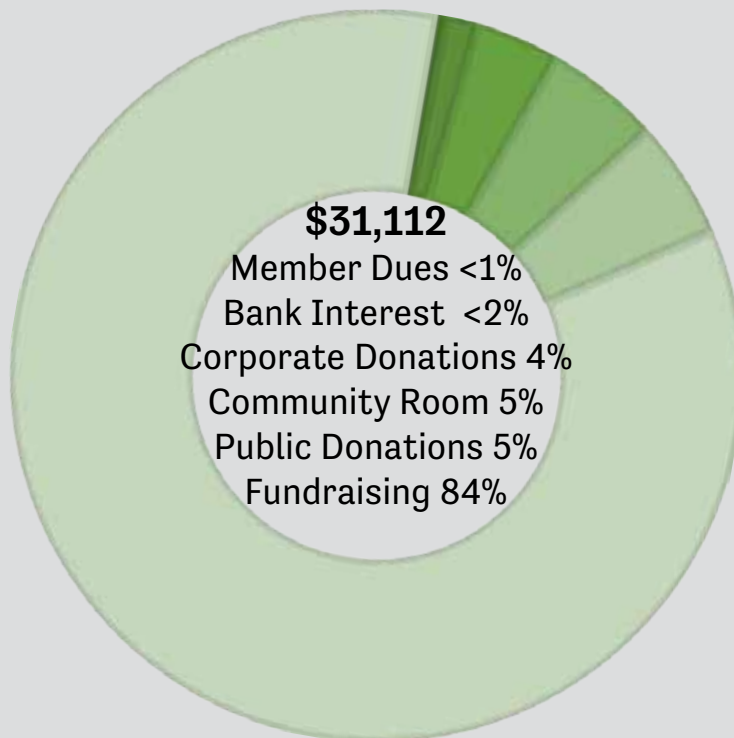




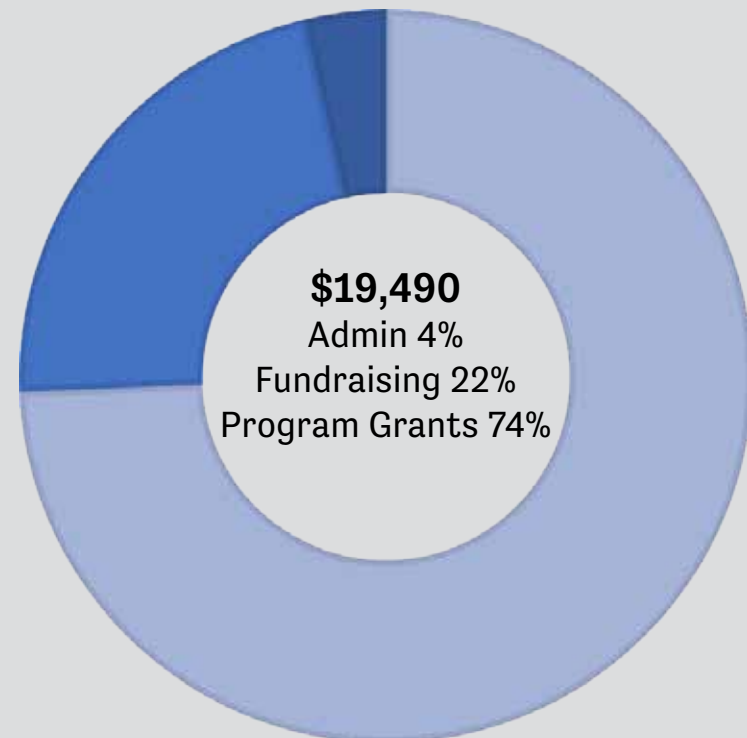
Financials

We apply 100% of public donations to program grants given to Marion Fire District. At the end of 2020, we had net cash assets of \$55,587. However, approximately \$26,000 in our savings account is earmarked to purchase a Jaws of Life extrication tools system for Marion Fire District in 2021.
